SCHOOL PE KIT – ALL CHILDREN ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE THEIR INDOOR AND OUTDOOR PE KIT IN SCHOOL WITH THEM AT ALL TIMES. PE is a statutory requirement of the curriculum and children must have the correct kit in order to progress with their learning along with representing the school well at tournaments. All children must have indoor pumps and for KS2 children, they are required to have outdoor trainers as well. *It is probably worth checking that both still fit!*

Earrings and Hair - for health & safety reasons, earrings must also be removed by the child for all PE lessons. If children are unable to remove them by themselves, they should bring in some tape to keep in their drawer or PE bag so that they can tape over their earrings each time they do PE. Hair that is long enough to be tied up must be tied up and headbands also removed. We **DO NOT** hold any spare kit in school for children to use. Also, children should not be expected to lend their kit to others for hygiene reasons.
