### PARKING AROUND SCHOOL

Whilst it is good to know that some parents and carers are watching out for unsafe and illegal parking around school in order to ensure the safety of our children, please note that some people may not be breaking the law by parking on yellow lines. People who hold **BLUE DISABLED BADGES** 'may park on single or double yellow lines for up to 3 hours if it is safe to do so but not within 15 metres of a junction or where there are restrictions on loading or unloading – indicated by yellow kerb dashes and/or signs on plates'.
