- Encourage children to maintain high levels of behaviour by following the school rules and behaviour policy.
- Keep you informed about school activities through weekly newsletters, notices and our website.
- Set and monitor appropriate home learning tasks.
- Be on hand to listen and respond to any concerns parents may have; offering advice and support when necessary.

- Take an interest in what my child is learning at school.
- Give praise for good work and behaviour in school.
- Support the school's Christian ethos and values.
- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and arrives on time, notifying school of all absences and reasons for this.
- Minimise the disruption in learning by not taking family holidays during term time.
- Support with homework activities, projects and other learning opportunities at home.
- Let the school know of any concerns or problems that might affect your child's progress or behaviour.
- Support the school's policies, including the behaviour and anti-bullying policy, ensuring that other pupils, staff and property are respected.
- Attend any Parents' Consultation meetings as necessary to discuss your child's progress.
- Raise any concerns promptly with your child's class teacher in the first instance.
- Refrain from using any social media to:
 - display photographs of school events
 - or voice any concerns

- Enjoy learning new things and ask questions.
- Treat others with respect and kindness.
- Take care of school property.
- Conduct themselves within the shared Christian values of our school.
- Talk to members of staff or parents about any worries or concerns.
