
Communication home is always informative.

Communication has been extremely thorough from Securing a place through to starting school and beyond


The Information Evening (held in June) gave us enough information about school life and starting school.








Starting school full time in September enabled my child to settle in well into the school routine.




Much prefer full time in reception from the start. Due to Stanley being in nursery the transition was really smooth

The class are lovely. He doesn't have a bad word to say about anyone.




All staff and children who attend the school are so friendly and kind helping my child to settle in well. Thank you to all of you for being so lovely.

The new starters visit from Reverend Stephen made my child feel part of the church community.


