#### HOW TO ENT

You'll need to register an account a a parent/guardian. The school is registered so when you have an account, you can log in and submit your child's work and select Barkisland CE (VA) Primary School from the list.

Select 'I am a parent' and enter you details. You will then be asked to upload an image of the artwork.

#### What kind of artworks do you accept?

We've written <u>some guidance</u> on the kinds of artwork the judges are looking for when they review submissions. The artwork can be made using any material; it can be a painting sculpture, photograph, installation, vides, drawing, or a combination.
