Dear Parents and Carers,

Class 4 Summer Term Trip to Liverpool World Museum, Liverpool – Tuesday 10th June 2025

During the Summer Term, we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians in our History lessons. Therefore, a trip to the Liverpool World Museum to attend an Ancient Egyptian mummification workshop has been arranged.

We have booked a coach to leave school at approximately 9.15am to arrive in Liverpool at 11.00am where the coach will drop us off outside the museum. The mummification workshop will begin at 11.30am. It is important that the children arrive at school by 8.45am to avoid any delays to our day.

After the mummification workshop, the children will be given time to explore Liverpool World Museum's impressive collection of Ancient Egyptian artefacts as a group. We aim to be on the coach by 2.30pm. Our estimated arrival time back in school will be 4.15pm and if this changes on the day due to traffic, parents will be informed via school spider.

The cost of the trip is **£12.50** per child and we are asking parents and carers for a voluntary donation to cover these costs and payment is now available on School Spider and should be made by Friday 6th June. The BSA have very kindly agreed to pay for half of the coach fees which significantly reduces the costs. If your child would like to go but you are unable to meet the cost of their trip, please do get in touch with us, in confidence.

All children will require a packed lunch for the day. **Those children who currently have school dinners will be provided with a packed lunch from school on the morning of the trip.** School prepared packed lunches will include: a sandwich (children will choose from a choice of fillings in class), either a fairy cake or homemade biscuit along with a carton of fruit juice or bottled water. Children who bring packed lunches from home will be expected to do so on the trip day. Please note: we are a nut free school therefore please do not send any produce that contains, or may contain nuts. **If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch please let us know on the School Spider consent form.** All packed lunch items need to be entirely disposable but no glass bottles please.
